Montague Villages helps adults over sixty residing in the Town of Montague to age in place with dignity and independence by offering volunteer services, access to information, and community connections.

OUR HISTORY

More than a year ago a group of Montague residents began meeting to determine the need and desire for a "village" network of neighborly volunteers to help people 60 and over who wish to continue living independent, engaged lives in their homes. From those meetings, Montague Villages was formed. More than 150 people have expressed interest.

The organization is part of the national Village-to-Village network, a member-driven non-profit organization that has grown from just one "village" in Boston to more than 350 nation-wide.

WHAT'S HAPPENING NOW?

Montague Villages established an eightmember Board of Directors, working committees, as well as getting assistance from individuals, to successfully make our vision operational. Our fiscal sponsor, Common Good, provides non-profit status and allows individuals to make taxdeductible donations. Many local businesses and individuals have contributed funds to support our mission. We continue to seek donations for operating expenses such as insurance, printing, outreach, and events. In order to develop community connections to Montague Villages, and increase awareness of our goals, we will soon hold information sessions and events.

Members of our Volunteer and Membership Committees are creating volunteer and membership application forms and handbooks. Volunteers will organize attend orientation and training sessions; and for the safety and security of everyone, all volunteers must agree to a CORI check.

WHAT WILL BE OFFERED

Depending on interests and abilities, we hope our volunteers will:

- Provide rides to appointments, grocery stores, medical appointments, libraries and more.
- Help with simple household chores, light yard work, and technical support.
- Offer phone checks and/or companionship visits.
- Provide referrals for tasks beyond the scope of our volunteers.
- Respond to community needs as they evolve.
